Dear President,

I am writing in order to follow up with my letter dated 27th October 2009 (see attached) in which I raised the issue of the right to organize European Elite Road Championships (men and women except for UCI Pro Team riders) starting from 2011. We have discussed this issue couple of times before and you surely remember that I have made a few attempts to obtain for Europe the right to organize this event.

As I am aware of, it is not up to you personally to make this decision. As the President of the UEC I would like to express the opinion of all European Cycling Federations and draw your attention to the fact that it is important for us (UEC) to struggle against discrimination of our confederation by the UCI and to change the art. 10.1.001 of the UCI CR.

Therefore, I have a kind and official request to include in the agenda of the next UCI Management Board meeting a voting on my proposal to leave out the words in brackets from the article 10.1.001 (see below):

10.1.001 The Continental Championships are organised each year under the responsibility of the Continental Confederations, at least for the Olympic disciplines and the elite category **(except for Europe)** and are entered on the Continental Calendar on a fixed date chosen in agreement with the UCI. The enrolment request must reach the UCI before 1st June of the previous year.

Dear President, once again I ask you on behalf of European Cycling Federations to put an end to the discrimination of European Cycling.
